## Courses Offered

Summer Courses will be offered at **B. MacNaughton High School**, 999 St. George St., Moncton. Classes will begin at 8:00 AM and 9:35 AM. Students can register for 1 or 2 of the 90 minute classes.

Courses in **Math and English** will be offered to students from **Grades 6 to 12**. Other courses, including **French, Social Studies, History, Science, Chemistry, Physics and Biology** may also be offered. However, **any course** with sufficient enrollments will be offered.

All courses will be available for any student who wishes remediation in a subject area. This includes those who have **failed a credit or grade** and those who **have passed but wish to improve a mark** to better prepare for the next grade or to meet post-secondary entrance requirements. Attendance is mandatory and students absent for more than 2 classes may be withdrawn.

## Entrance Requirements

### Grades 6,7,8

Students in grades 6 to 8 must have the **signature of their principal** on their application forms if they were not promoted. Students attending to improve and better prepare for the next grade require no signature.

### Grade 9

Grade 9 students **must be recommended for summer school by the signature of a teacher or administrator** on either their application form or their report card.

### Grades 10,11,12

Grades 10, 11 & 12 students must have attained a mark of **at least 50** in the course for which they are registering. They must **bring their report card when registering.** Students who **have passed a course may attend for improvement** in order to better prepare for the next course or to meet minimum post-secondary standards. The new higher summer school mark will replace their previous mark.

Students who have marks below 50 may also attend but must have the signature of a school administrator.
